



WALL TO WALL RIDE FOR REMEMBRANCE 2021

AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN A MOTORCYCLE RIDING EVENT

Warning: This is an important document which affects your rights and obligations. You must read this document carefully. Do not click the agreement button below or submit your registration unless you are satisfied you understand and agree with the matters contained within it. If you are in any doubt about your rights and obligations, you should first seek legal advice before signing this document.

By submitting the 'Wall to Wall Ride for Remembrance 2021' form, you acknowledge and agree with the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1 (hereinafter collectively called "the Organiser") that you are by this Agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle riding event listed in Schedule 2 (herein called "the Event") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

I acknowledge that motorcycle riding is dangerous and that by engaging in this activity and participating in the Event I am exposed to certain risks and dangers and that I have certain obligations including:-

- (a) that I may be seriously injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- (b) that my motorcycle, property or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- (c) that other participants may ride dangerously or with lack of due skill care and attention causing injury, damage or death to myself, my motorcycle or my property;
- (d) that the roads or conditions encountered during the course of the Event may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability and without the knowledge of the Organiser;
- (e) that the Organiser and any agent or representative of the Organiser may be required to make decisions under pressure of time and in response to unforeseen conditions or circumstances encountered during the Event;
- (f) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life, my motorcycle or my property may be voided;
- (g) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for my treatment or transportation to medical facilities if I am injured or killed in the course of the Event;
- (h) that I have an obligation to myself and to other participants in the Event as well as other road users to participate safely in the Event;
- (i) that I have an obligation and agree to abide by all laws and regulations, including all road traffic laws, regulations and rules, in all States and Territories in which the Event is conducted;
- (j) that I have an obligation and agree to abide by all reasonable requests and directions made by the Organiser during the course of the Event;
- (k) that I am personally responsible for ensuring that I wear appropriate protective clothing and equipment at all times during the Event.

INDEMNITY

In consideration of the Organiser accepting my application to participate in the Event, I agree to release and indemnify and to keep indemnified and to hold harmless the Organiser and each of them including their servants, agents, officeholders and officials from and against all actions, claims, suits and demands including any claims for costs, expenses and damages (of any kind whatsoever) arising out of or in any way relating to the Event or my death or any injury, loss or damage caused to or by me or my motorcycle, property or equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty of care or in any other manner whatsoever.

CANCELLATION DISCLAIMER

The Event requires significant management and coordination by the Organiser (with authorities and similar external agencies). In the event of any foreseen or unforeseen cancellation of the Event, for any reason, the Organiser reserves the right to retain the entirety of the registration fee paid by the ride participant and does not accept any liability for any costs, claims, charges, expenses or damages incurred by the ride participant arising out of or in relation to the cancellation of the Event. Furthermore, a major portion of the registration fee will be donated to the Police Legacy Organisation of the Rider's choice regardless of whether the event is cancelled.

The wall to wall ride for remembrance will commence from various locations.

ACT Region - After a short 9.00am ACT Regional Memorial Service at National Police Memorial in Kings Park ACT, the ACT Regional Ride departs under AFP Escort to NSWPF Academy, Goulburn.

New South Wales - Ride Participants are invited to meet at New South Wales Police memorial site, Art Gallery Road, Domain Sydney on ride day. Riders will travel under police supervision on major arterial roads and the Hume Highway to the New South Wales Police Academy, Goulburn. Riders will then travel via the Federal Highway to the designated meeting point at Exhibition Park In Canberra (EPIC) to meet other participants.

Following a short memorial service at 0700 hours at PFES Remembrance Wall on The Esplanade Darwin City ride departs 7 – 10 days prior to Wall to Wall Ride in Canberra.

Tasmania – Ride participants wishing to travel with the official party (marked bikes and riders), are advised that they will depart from the Police Academy Rokeby at 12pm (TBC) on the 10th September and make their way to Devonport under police escort and catch the Spirit to Melbourne (overnight), arriving on 11th. Riders will then attend the Victorian memorial ceremony (on St Kilda Road) and following this will join the Victorian ride to Canberra in its entirety. Other riders leaving early will make their own way to Canberra.
